

Dear Parent:

The defeat of Measure E, our local parcel tax originally passed by our community in 2009, sent shockwaves through our schools. Without this stable source of local funding, approximately \$4.1 million will have to be cut from our school district's annual budget – resulting in the lay off of over 30 teachers that provide instruction in advanced academics, arts and physical education.

WHAT CAN EACH OF US DO TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE?

You can make a difference by **voting YES on Measure E** and **donating to the San Marino Schools Foundation before May 15.** Both these actions are pivotal for the continued excellence of our schools and to avoid catastrophic deterioration of our schools.

VOTE FOR MEASURE E ON JUNE 29

Our first priority is to pass Measure E this June 29. Now, more than ever, renewing the parcel tax before it expires in June is critical. If Measure E fails, the District faces devastating losses, which cannot be minimized. This critical funding generates \$4.1 million annually for 6 years to keep highly qualified teachers, preserve small class sizes, protect arts and physical education, and maintain advanced and honor academic courses that prepare students for success. We cannot imagine what our schools would look like without these monies.

We ask you to step up, get involved and VOTE Yes in the June 29 all mail-ballot election.
